

Charleston WreathFest Frequently Asked Questions

What is Charleston WreathFest?

Charleston WreathFest is a community project to make downtown attractive and festive for holiday shoppers and visitors. To participate, businesses will hang live wreaths on their doors or windows during the season in a unified expression of holiday abundance and joy.

Who organized it?

This project is coordinated by the Charleston Peninsula Preservation Trust together with Thackeray Farms, a locally owned small farm on Wadmalaw Island, and other Charleston community organizations.

Who can participate?

All peninsula businesses are invited to participate in WreathFest attention, spirit and festivities.

To enter the contest, purchase live Frasier Fir wreaths from the organizers in one of three sizes. In an arrangement with the Charleston Peninsula Preservation Trust, locally-owned Thackeray Farms is offering special prices and free delivery on Christmas Wreaths. The most imaginative, beautiful and spirited entries will receive media attention and can win valuable prizes.

How can I enter?

What can I win?

There's a community service award to post in your business, a year of window and sidewalk cleaning, advertising in the Post and Courier and on the popular King Street Marketing Group websites, brunch at Halls Chophouse, and more.

- Take proper care to insure that your wreath is securely installed on your door.
- If possible, avoid placing your wreath near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Mist your wreath with fresh water daily.
- Take your wreath inside when your business is closed.
